# Requirements for Participation in St. Paul's Home- Based Faith Formation Program 2021-2022

"As the primary educators of their children,
parents have the right and the duty to choose the kind of educational environment
that they determine best suits their children's educational needs.

Therefore, home-based faith formation is a viable option for the general education of children.
If Catholic parents choose to provide catechesis for the children in their home,
that catechesis must be both complete and authentic. The home-based catechesis of children
is a cooperative effort between the children, their parents, parish leadership, and the diocesan bishop.

Parents who choose to be not only the primary educators of their children, but also their catechists
must adhere to all guidelines for catechists as outlined by the diocesan bishop." (GDC #61)

- 1. Families and students participating in the home-based program must be registered each year with St. Paul's Religious Education Office.
- Textbooks, grade level curriculum and objectives will be obtained from the RE Office. Parents and students must be committed to completing one lesson per week.
   Lesson instructions will be posted using the Flipgrid platform.
- 3. After completing each chapter, the students will use the Flipgrid E-Assessment to demonstrate understanding of the chapter information.
- Parents and students must attend the Home-Based Faith Formation Kickoff in the School Cafeteria.

   Grade level materials and resources will be distributed.
   Instructions/expectations for the program will be presented.
- 5. Both Parents and students are to attend 3 additional mandatory Family Enrichment & Checkpoint Sessions. All meetings will take place in the St. Paul's School Cafeteria.
